Award Description:

The Children's Week Florida Mouth Advocate Award is presented to a young person who has worked diligently over the past year as an advocate, initiating positive change for themselves, their peers, their communities, or statewide. Youth advocate efforts and examples may include, but are not limited to:

- creating awareness
- engaging in creative efforts and activities
- demonstrating strong youth leadership
- working collaboratively to improve the lives of others
- supporting programs and/or policies that have benefited children and families

This **2023 Youth Advocate Award** recipient will be honored on **Monday, March 27, 2023** during the Children's Week Florida[™] Advocacy Dinner and Awards Ceremony. The award recipient will also be invited to participate in Children's Week Florida[™] events across the week, including Children's Day at the Capitol (March 28) and Teen Thursday (March 30).

Eligibility Criteria:

- Nominees must be under 18 or in school (K-12) at the time of their nomination.
- Nominees should be currently involved in advocacy efforts or actively encouraging ongoing advocacy efforts at the local or state level that have improved the lives of children, youth, and families.
- Teachers, parents, mentors, students, and others are invited to submit a nomination for a youth advocate that inspires them; or youth may nominate themselves.

To Submit a Nomination:

- 1. Complete all fields and sign the **Nominee Information Form**.
- 2. Provide answers and complete the **Nominee Narrative/Personal Statement**. This section should describe the nominee's contributions and/or commitment to serving children, youth, and families.
- 3. Include a recent **Photo** of nominee (*jpeg or png*).

Additional Information:

- Nominations will be reviewed by the Children's Week Florida™ Advocacy Awards Committee, a volunteer peer review group consisting of previous Chiles Advocacy Award winners, community partners, and other advocates.
