Artwork Instructions

Tens of thousands of paper cut-outs of children's hands are hung in the Capitol Rotunda during Children's Week. Please follow the artwork instructions exactly to ensure your hand art is displayed.

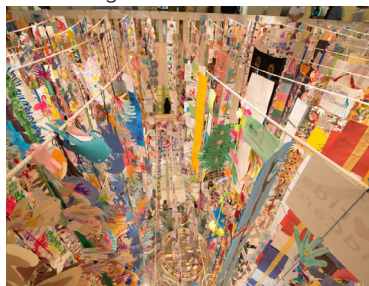
We encourage you to decorate the hands with colorful artwork, **PS** stories **PS** Qres . You can also use the hands to create a small posters (no larger than 11x14). *Be as creative as you possibly can!*

- Artwork is to be stapled onto string or ribbon vertically. Please ensure that the string is secure before sending.
- String or ribbon must be in lengths of eight (8) to ten (10) feet. Longer strings will be cut as needed.
- Hand art must be strung together and secured prior to mailing. Please do not send individual hands.
- Please do not send any items larger than 11x14.
